Parents and families,

The Clarke County School District is excited to offer a face-to-face instructional option for high school students beginning March 15. Implementation of a phase-in approach will allow us to support a safe transition to student return. Our instructional day will begin at 9:00am and end at 1:00pm. Details on each phase and next steps are below:

Phase 1 March 15th

This phase includes a short term plan to gradually return students to our classrooms. Students will be divided into four groups alphabetically (A1, A2, B1, B2). During this time, students will rotate in-person days (A1 Monday, A2 Tuesday, B1 Thursday, B2 Friday). The asynchronous day for students will change to Wednesdays instead of Fridays. This change will align our elementary, middle and high school students' instructional days while including high schools in district-wide deep cleaning efforts on Wednesdays. This instructional model will be primarily simultaneous; with the allowance for other instructional models where deemed appropriate.

Phase 2 March 22nd

In phase 2 we will engage our face-to-face students using an A/B rotation. This means all students in the A cohort (A1 and A2) that have chosen the face-to-face option will do so on Monday & Tuesday, while all B cohort students will do the same on Thursday and Friday. Wednesday will remain an asynchronous workday for students.

Upon return from Spring Break (April 5th- 9th), Wednesday instruction will be synchronous for the remainder of the year and/or a return to a full 5 days per week of in person instruction.

The window to make your selection for virtual or face-to-face instruction is now open and closes on February 19th (for high school students). To make this selection, log in to your [Infinite Campus](#) account. There will also be an opportunity to make changes during parent/teacher conferences. After February 19th, all instructional model selections will be final and remain throughout the remainder of the school year.

Dual Enrollment Students

Students that participate in dual enrollment through the ACCA and directly with colleges and universities will need to work individually with your school counselor to determine any schedule modifications that may need to be made.
